Ordinance No. 13-1997

Passed September 3, 1997

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF MT. EATON WAYNE COUNTY, OHIO DIRECTING THE CLERK OF THE VILLAGE OF MT. EATON, OHIO TO ESTABLISH A MAYOR'S COURT COMPUTER FUND.

WHEREAS, Section 1901.261 of the Ohio Revised Code permits the establishment of a fund to pay the cost to computerize the office of the Clerk of Court; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that a computer system will provide for the efficient operation of Mayor's Court; and

WHEREAS, in order to underwrite the cost for the computer system, it is necessary to collect fees;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village of Mt. Eaton, Wayne County, Ohio that:

Section 1. The Clerk of the Village of Mt. Eaton is hereby directed to establish a Mayor's Court Computer Fund.

Section 2. All monies collected by the Village of Mt. Eaton attributable to the Mayor's Court Computer Fund shall be deposited by the Treasurer of the Village into said fund.

Section 3. Monies deposited in said fund shall be used exclusively for the purchase of a computer system for Mayor's Court and for any upgrades, updates or maintenance required thereof as determined by Council.

Section 4. A fee of Ten and 00/100 Dollars (10.00) shall be collected for the said fund from any case heard in Mayor's Court, and such fee shall be in addition to those fees and costs presently assessed.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law.
