

ORDINANCE NO. 8-1989

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF MOUNT EATON, WAYNE COUNTY, OHIO, TO RENEW THE VILLAGE INCOME TAX AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village finds that the income to the Village generated by the Village Income Tax enacted as Ordinance No. 4-1984 is essential for the continued operation of the government of the Village; and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance expires by its terms effective August 6, 1989;

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MOUNT EATON, WAYNE COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the annual tax levied under Ordinance No. 4-1989 be and is hereby imposed on and after August 6, 1989 for a period of one (/) year(s), or until repealed.

Section 2: That the definitions, terms of imposition of tax, provisions for returns, reciprocity, collection, declarations, treasurer's duties, treasurer's powers, interest and penalties and penalties for failure to comply with said ordinance be and they are hereby incorporated in this ordinance as if fully rewritten herein, the only modification of the terms of said ordinance being the effective date and term.

Section 4: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that the provision of governmental services to residents of the Village is dependent upon the revenue generated by the Village Income Tax, by reason whereof this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage.
